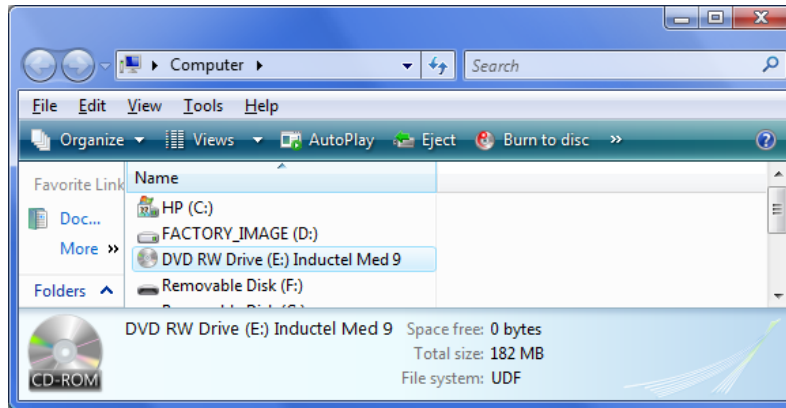
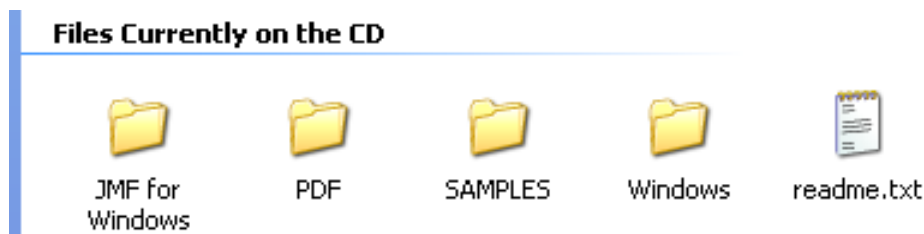


## Inductel Program Installation Guide for Microsoft Windows

Start your computer. Place your Inductel CD, or DVD, in the appropriate drive.



Next, double click on the **CD, or DVD, drive icon** to view the contents of the Inductel disk. Then open the “**Windows**” folder.



In the “Windows” folder, double click on the “**install**” file and follow the instructions that will appear on your display. At some point, the installation program will ask you to choose a **shortcut folder** where you wish to create the program icon. The program icon is what you will use to start your Inductel program.



**Note 1:** This software gives you the option of installing a custom dictionary in your word processing program. For certain word processing programs, our installation program will install a custom dictionary named “custom.dic” that will **overwrite** the existing custom dictionary. Therefore, if you plan to install your Inductel custom dictionary into Microsoft Access 2000 through 2003, Microsoft Excel 2000 through 2003, Microsoft Outlook 2000 through 2003, Microsoft PowerPoint 2000 through 2003, or Microsoft Works, you may want to **rename** or **back up** your existing “custom.dic” .

**Note 2:** You must **activate**, or enable, your Inductel custom dictionary before it can be used by your word processing program to check spelling. To learn how to activate it, you should view the **spell checker activation instructions** offered after the installation of your Inductel program is complete.

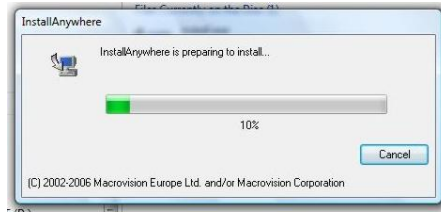
Technical Note: If you have multiple user accounts on your computer, your Inductel program should be installed from an Administrator’s account. For installation purposes, Administrator’s account name should contain letters and numbers only, no special characters or punctuation marks. Otherwise, the install program may not run.

Technical Note: On some computers, you may also have to temporarily turn off your firewall in order to allow the install program to run. You may turn your firewall back on afterward.

## Inductel Installation Instructions Addendum For Windows Vista and Windows 7

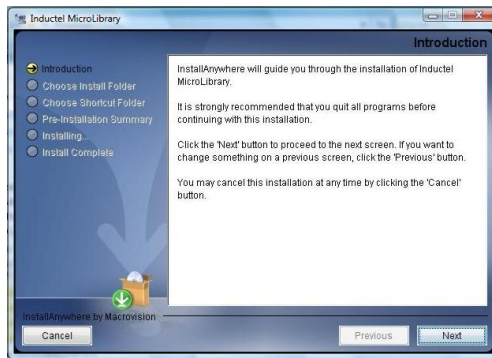
Shortly after you start the “install” file, a progress bar should appear. Its appearance indicates that the installation program is “unpacking.”



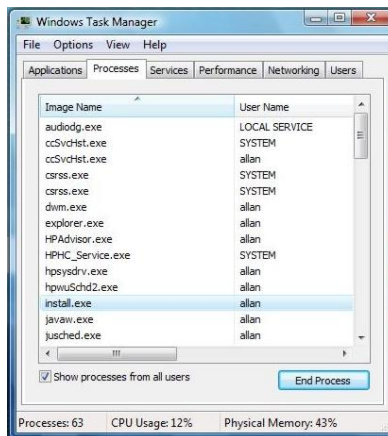
Sometimes, however, the progress bar might not appear even though the installation program is operational. That may give the impression that the installation program has stopped working when in fact it is busily unpacking. Please be patient.

If the progress bar has not appeared within a few seconds of starting the “install” file, then there are two things you may do.

First, you may wait for the “Introduction” window to appear. Its appearance will let you know that the installation program is working.



Second, you may close the current copy of the install file, and start a new copy of it. Use the Windows Task Manager to shut down the first copy of the install file. Bring up the Task Manager by holding down the Alt, Ctrl, and Del keys simultaneously. In the Task Manager, under the “Processes” tab, highlight the “install.exe” entry, and click on the “End Process” button. After you have done that, exit the Task Manager, and start the “install.exe” again.

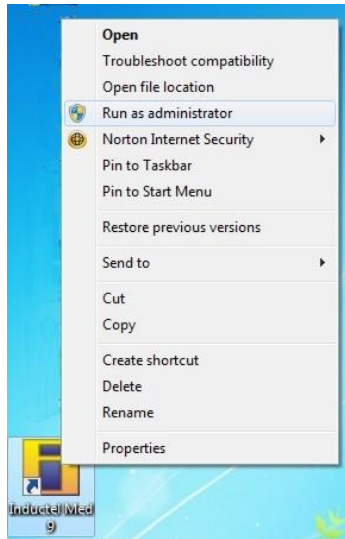
## Inductel Installation Instructions Addendum For Windows 7

When you run your Inductel program in Windows 7, you might get the following error message for security reasons.



If you get that error message, click on the OK button, and close your Inductel program.

Next, right click on the Inductel program icon with your mouse, and elect to “Run as administrator” as shown in the picture below.
